



## RAMP Town Hall Q&A

- **Q:** Are the RAMP curriculum lists available in MasonLEAPS? I've looked and while I can find many individual videos, I don't see a curriculum list.
- **A:** All of the resources will be available in MasonLEAPS by searching RAMP. We will be providing on ramp.gmu.edu a list of which guides/videos are recommended by role.
- **Q:** How will PIs access RAMP? What will they be able to see?
- A: Answered Live
- **Q:** Can you explain what is meant by JIT state?
- A: JIT stands for "Just in Time"; this is an NIH term but the RAMP application uses this for revisions or additional info the Sponsor needs after initial submission of the proposal.
- **Q:** Where in this process does the funding application connect to a specific request for proposals from a sponsor so that the application contains the correct elements and is reviewed by the correct persons?

- **Q:** In the past, I have sent biosketches to my grants administrator. Can I still do that or will I need to upload it here?
- **A:** You can upload biosketches at anytime during the proposal preparation process directly into RAMP or send to your administrator to upload into RAMP.
- **Q:** Is there going to be an easy way to get Current and Pending reporting through RAMP?

- **Q:** How would you indicate that you also want a Center as an administrative unit to be listed/credited (e.g. CRASC)?

- **Q:** Can the faculty submitting the application choose any staff member as their support admin? Or are they directed to particular staff?

- Q: Does RAMP carry over a PI's existing/past proposal requests? Or does it only house future proposal requests?
- A: We will be migrating the following into RAMP: 1) Proposals that have been submitted to the sponsor as of July 6; 2) Active Awards as of July 6.
